The NSW Government is running a Washing Machine Replacement Trial that helps eligible social housing tenants to replace their inefficient top-loading washing machine with a new, front-loading washing machine at a heavily discounted price. This will help households save around \$245 a year off their water, energy and detergent bills.

Elisa's Story

Brisbane-born midwife Elisa was excited about her new role in a maternity ward at Westmead, but she was also bracing herself for the prospect of having to live a long way from her work.

"Sydney is a great place to live but enjoying all the city has to offer is hard when prices are so high," Elisa said.

"I didn't want to be spending all my money on rent and transport and stuck far away from the few friends I have in Sydney."

For Elisa, the answer turned out to be a tenancy with SGCH at the Highline development at Westmead, 85 apartments catering for key and essential workers – people working in jobs like Elisa's.

"I work shifts – often starting very early in the morning – so long commutes on public transport would have been hard. I'm also new to Sydney so I wanted to be close to friends so I can enjoy the limited downtime that I do have.

"I feel so lucky to have found SGCH and my brand-new apartment, which is a less than 10-minute walk to my work. It's such a great space and the Highline has great amenities including a communal swimming pool and BBQ area, and it's an easy walk to transport to anywhere. I am not spending all my money on rent, and I have colleagues who also live in Highline or close by," she said.



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
