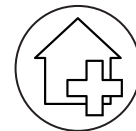

No Interest Loan Scheme

Interest free loans to buy goods and services.

We are a registered NILS Service Provider and can help you apply for an interest free loan of up to \$2,000 (for repayment up to 24 months). You can use the loan for goods and services such as fridges, furniture, washing machines, car repairs, education, medical and dental costs.

DigiConnect

Buy discounted digital devices to repay over one year.

The DigiConnect program gives tenants the opportunity to buy digital devices at a discount from regular retail price.

Choose one of the devices we have on offer and pay us back through fortnightly repayments over one year, with no interest.

The items on offer change periodically due to availability.

Strive Scholarships

Scholarships for primary, secondary

and tertiary students to help with the costs of education.

The Strive Scholarships program helps students in primary, secondary or tertiary education to pursue their goals. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$1,500 based on age group. You can spend the scholarship money on education fees, extra-curricular activities like sports and creative interests, or study resources like computers, books, school supplies and tuition costs.



Catalyst

Catalyst is a program we offer to support your employment and training goals.

There are three parts to Catalyst: Coaching; Training; and Funding. You can access all three or only one, depending on your needs.

Coaching involves individual support like help with your resume, practice interviews and post-placement support. Training involves learning job skills in a group environment, and funding can help with the cost of things like work-related licensing.
