

Affordable Housing for Aboriginal People in Sydney



Factsheet



Three not-for-profit providers of affordable housing in Sydney, Bridge Housing, City West Housing and SGCH, have partnered to employ an Aboriginal Housing Engagement Coordinator (AHEC).

The role is funded by the City of Sydney and was established to create pathways for Aboriginal people to find and apply for affordable housing.

Different to community housing and public housing, affordable housing is for people who are employed but who earn very low to moderate incomes.

The rent for affordable housing is less than private rent to make living close to work, education and/ or social and family connections more affordable.

Affordable housing programs operate under different guidelines depending on how the program is funded. Different programs have different eligibility criteria including connection to the local area, income eligibility and employment status.

The AHEC can help guide you through the process of finding the right affordable housing program for you.


