Lithium-ion batteries are the fastest growing fire risk in New South Wales. They can explode, releasing toxic, flammable gases that ignite quickly and make fires hard to extinguish.

- Always dispose of old batteries at your local recycling point.

Monday is your new billing day

From Monday 18 August, we will begin charging all customers on Mondays for rent and shared water. Currently, we charge you on different days of the week.

The new Monday billing day will happen automatically, so there's nothing you need to do. It will not

affect the amount we charge you for weekly rent or shared water, or your Centrepay cycle. If you check your bills regularly, you may notice your balance is slightly higher or lower, for the week starting Monday 18 August. We're making these changes so it's easier to track your account and plan payments.
