## Clean up and repair days Sydney wide

There must be a sense of spring in the air! SGCH customers across Sydney have been busy taking part in clean-up activities and making the most of recent Fix and Mix events, where our teams carry out quick repairs on the spot.

One customer said, "I've been able to get rid of items I've been holding onto for a while and couldn't get rid of myself. It's like a fresh start for me." Another appreciated some extra hands to help: "My place was very crowded. Today was beautiful and thank you for my cleaning pack."

Over the last 12 months we've held a total of 11 events, jam packed 11 skip bins and booked seven Council collections for those unwanted household items. SGCH teams actioned 140 repairs and customers took home 70 cleaning kits. Thank you to everyone at our properties in Kingsgrove, Sadlier, Roselands, Merrylands, Gladesville, Milsons Point, Marrickville, Caringbah, Petersham, Hunters Hill and Lane Cove who joined in with their local clean-up.

## Customers connect over art lessons

Exhibition *Brushes at Bushlands* opened in recent weeks to a friendly crowd of SGCH staff and customers. It showcased artworks from five Lane Cove customers who had signed up for a 10-week program, led by our very own SGCH artist Adnan. Some of the participants, all aged over 50, hadn't touched a paintbrush since their school days and enjoyed learning new skills. This program was funded thanks to a grant from Lane Cove Council.
